

Description: Colourless water-based primer for slightly powdering and untreated substrates. Ideally suitable as a primer for Finess Concrete & Floor Paint. Do not use as a base coat on paint surfaces in good condition. For interior and exterior use.

Use: For substrates that require stabilising such as chalking, powdering or sandy substrates. Concrete and cement are suitable substrates.

Properties:

- Solvent-free
- Virtually odourless
- Colourless
- Good penetration capacity
- Improves adhesion
- Fixes the substrate
- Breathable and quick-drying

Colour: Colourless

Application: Stir thoroughly prior to use. Apply as an undiluted coat using a brush or a woolly roller.

Covers: Approximately 10 m²/litre per coat depending on the absorbency of the substrate.

Drying time at 23°C and relative humidity of 65%:

Dry after approximately 1 hour.

Can be painted over after approximately 4 hours.

SYSTEM CONSTRUCTION

Substrate: The surface must be clean, dry and free from dust or grease. Repair cracks and fissures. Remove and restore any loose and unstable coats.

Powdering, porous and absorbent substrates: Clean thoroughly with water and degreasing agent, let the surface dry. Then apply a coat of Finess Primer of Concrete & Floor Paint.

TECHNICAL DATA

Binding agent: Acrylic dispersion

Performance: Provides good adhesion to the top coat. Fixes the substrate.

Storage: Minimum of 12 months in the tightly sealed original packaging in a dry, cool and frost-free place.

General: Do not apply at temperatures below +8°C, in direct sunlight or when rain is expected. Allow newly cemented surfaces to set for at least 6 weeks.

Surplus product: This product and the packaging should be disposed of at a collection point for hazardous or special waste.
